THE PROJECT

Together, under the guidance of Tink Tank's Professional Mentors, we will create another couple of Episodes of Tink Tank's Mama's Ducks Pre-School Animated TV Series. Every participant will create their very own short animated story about ducklings. The individual shorts will be written by you, designed by you, and animated by you. If voice overs are needed, we will enlist either yourself or use one of the Voice Over actors on our VO roster. (see Voice Over Actor Workshop at end of this notice). *All content must be family friendly*.

In addition to the main movie, a Behind-The-Scenes film will be created, allowing each participant screen time to discuss the scene they created.

Note* The Project at hand has been designed to engage the most novice of artists to the most advanced of artists. Together we will all support each other and make a beautiful masterpiece together.

- Ability and interest in drawing, puppetry, or sculpture (You do not need any animation experience)
- Computer with High Speed Internet, Camera, Mouse & ability to Zoom
- Adobe Animate or Photoshop (can use free trials)
- Ability to follow multi-step directions

- Ability to manage a mouse and keyboard independently
- Behavioral support is permitted (*Parents/Guardians/Helpers*)
- A 15 minute Zoom assessment between the Artist, their support, and Mentor Dorenfeld

Project Director: Tawd b. Dorenfeld has come from a rich history of award winning animation production, music video production, film, and television production. And if you know anything about Tink Tank Animate, you know he focuses all of that knowledge onto the neurodiverse artists who participate in the Tink Tank programs.

Production Mentor: Douglas Freel has produced some of the biggest music videos from the late 80's into the 90's, until he began splitting his personal feature film projects with discovering and producing much of Dorenfeld's work. For the past year Doug has also been divulging tricks of the trade to the neurodiverse artists at Tink Tank.

Production Mentor: Animation Mentor Mary Andalaro is a graduate student at Central Michigan University working on her master's in Mental Health Counseling. Mary has a bachelor's degree in animation from Columbia College Chicago and has worked for Adult Swim. Mary is also working on her Registered Expressive Arts Therapist Certification (REAT)

Production Mentor: Animation Mentor Darrell Williams is a master of character animation capable of bringing fluidity and expression to anyone's style. His direct experience with in-home foster youths has shown his instinct for empathy and the value of instilling productivity and expression into marginalized communities. I love bringing ideas to life through the magic of animation. That is the core of what inspires me and I believe in sharing that passion with others.
